## COMMUNICATION FROM THE CHAIR

## THE PROPOSED REMOVAL FROM OFFICE, BY IMPEACHMENT, OF THE GOVERNOR OF KERICHO COUNTY-ADMISSIBILITY OF DOCUMENTS

- 1. The proceedings from the Speaker of the County Assembly of Kericho were received within two days of the resolution of the County Assembly, that is, the resolution was made on 14<sup>th</sup> May, 2014 and received by the Speaker of the Senate on 16<sup>th</sup> May, 2014. There is no requirement in the County Government Act for the Governor to be given the resolution of the County Assembly within two (2) days.
- 2. The County Assembly has submitted supplementary documents. The Governor had initially objected to the documents being produced but has now conceded to the same being produced. The Committee notes that some of the documents being produced are actually documents that the Governor has requested the County Assembly to produce. The other documents are High Court judgements and Gazette Notices. The Committee therefore admits the documents.
- 3. The Committee shall however not accept any further documents to be admitted in evidence save as may be requested by this Special Committee.
