The Senate will consider Bills at Second Reading, deliberate on Motions and any other business scheduled by the Senate Business Committee.

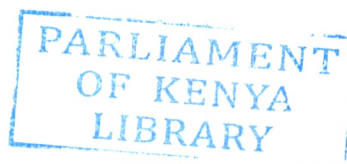
Let me once again appeal to Senators to make themselves available to dispose of pending business before the Senate especially Bills once we resume from recess.
