REQUEST FOR STATEMENT BY SEN. MOSES KAJWANG'

Mr. Speaker Sir,

Pursuant to Standing Order 45 (2) (b) I rise to seek a Statement from the Chairperson of the Standing Committee on National Security and Foreign Relations regarding the status of the National Security Communication System.

In the Statement, the Chairperson should state:-

1. the objective and the total cost of the project;
2. the geographic coverage of the project and what benefits Kenyans should expect from it;
3. the lead implementers of the said project and procedure under the Public Procurement and Disposal Act used to select and award the implementers;
4. the current status of this project and its expected date of completion;
5. the security agencies that will utilize the national security communication system being set up;
6. procedure under the Public Procurement and disposal Act used to allocate the 4G frequency spectrum license to the implementers of this project;
7. whether the amount paid for the 4G license been deposited in the consolidated fund;
8. the value of the 4G license and how much has been paid for it by the implementers; and
9. how the Government intends to take over control and management of this critical security communication network upon successful completion.
