- 3. the lead implementers of the said project and procedure under the Public Procurement and Disposal Act used to select and award the implementers;
- 4. the current status of this project and its expected date of completion;
- 5. the security agencies that will utilize the national security communication system being set up;
- procedure under the Public Procurement and disposal Act used to allocate the 4G frequency spectrum license to the implementers of this project;
- 7. whether the amount paid for the 4G license been deposited in the consolidated fund;
- 8. the value of the 4G license and how much has been paid for it by the implementers; and
- 9. how the Government intends to take over control and management of this critical security communication network upon successful completion.
