REQUEST FOR A STATEMENT ON THE CHANGE OF MEDICAL SERVICE PROVIDER FOR THE NATIONAL POLICE AND NATIONAL PRISON SERVICE FROM NHIF TO AAR INSURANCE

- c) Aware that no medical services are accorded to the officers and their families when they visit the newly opened AAR centres, what action is being taken to ensure the officers and their families are accorded necessary medical services?
- d) Is the Ministry of Interior and Coordination of National Government aware that there is disgruntlement amongst the officers regarding the provision of the AAR Insurance services?
- e) Could the NHIF Insurance cover be restored and the AAR Insurance cover shelved forthwith?
