- 1. Explain what is the reason behind this disturbing happenings in our Kenyan Schools: especially assor cases and steps to address the
- 2. State what the Ministry of Education is doing on the rising indiscipline in the schools;
- 3. State what measures the Ministry of Education has taken to find out the reasons behind the rising cases of arson in schools and how to alleviate the root cause(s);
- 3. State the way forward on how to prevent similar cases arising across the country.
