The National Government Constituencies Fund was allocated Kshs 47.2bn in the Financial Year 2022/2023.

The National Treasury has so far disbursed Kshs.18.0bn. In addition, a disbursement of 5.0bn is being processed this week and a further Kshs.5.0bn next week. This brings the total disbursements to Kshs.38.0bn. The National Treasury hopes to clear the outstanding balance of Kshs.19.2 billion by the close of the financial year.

The delay in keeping up with weekly disbursements of Kshs.2.0bn was occasioned by challenges in resource mobilization, both domestically and externally. However, the situation has improved with the disbursement of funds from World Bank Development Policy Operations facility.


#### 2. National Government Affirmative Action Fund (NGAAF)


