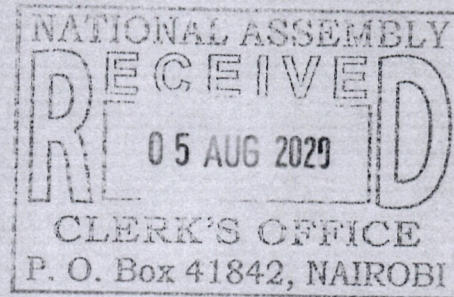

RE: SUBMISSION OF NOMINEES TO THE NATIONAL GOVERNMENT CONSTITUENCIES DEVELOPMENT FUND COMMITTEES FOR NATIONAL ASSEMBLY APPROVAL

Further to our letter ref. no. NG-CDFB/CEO/KNA/VOL VI (002) dated June 25, 2020 that forwarded the tenth batch of thirteen (13) Constituencies as well as one (1) re-submitted Constituency we wish to present a further seven (7) Constituencies as well as one (1) re-submitted Constituency based on the following premise.

Section 43 subsections (1.) and (2.) of the National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) Act 2015 as amended in 2016 states that:

“(1) there is established a National Government Constituency Development Fund Committee for every constituency.

(2) Each Constituency Committee shall comprise—

- (a.) The national government official responsible for coordination of national government functions;*
- (b.) Two men each nominated in accordance with subsection (3), one of whom shall be a youth at the date of appointment;*
- (c.) Two women nominated in accordance with subsection (3), one of whom shall be a youth at the date of appointment;*
- (d.) one person with disability nominated by a registered group representing persons with disabilities in the constituency in accordance*
- (e.) two persons nominated by the constituency office established under Regulations made pursuant to the Parliamentary Service Act”;*

Further, Subsections (3) and (4) provide that: -

“(3.) the seven persons referred to in subsection (2) (b), (c), (d) and (e) shall be selected in such manner and shall have such qualifications as the Board may, by regulations, prescribe.

(4.) The names of the persons selected under subsection (3) shall be submitted by the Board to the National Assembly for approval before appointment and gazettelement by the Board”

Pursuant to the above, the terms of office for the current National Government Constituencies Development Fund Committees (NGCDFCs) as contained in the following Gazette Notices lapsed as follows:-

- i. Gazette Notice No. 12015, Dated December 8, 2017 Contained In Vol. Cxix-No. 180, effective December 05, 2017, hence, **the members therein in respect of 264 constituencies were set for retirement/renewal on December 04, 2019;**
- ii. Gazette Notice No. 673 Dated December 19, 2017 Contained In Vol. Cxx-No. 11, effective December 19, 2017, hence **the members therein in respect of 23 constituencies were set for retirement /renewal on December 18, 2019;**
- iii. Gazette Notice No. 1718 Dated February 23, 2018 Contained In Vol. Cxx-No. 26, effective February 13, 2018, **the members therein in respect of 2 constituencies were set for retirement /renewal on February 12, 2020;**
- iv. Via Gazette Notice No. 5702 Dated May 21, 2018, Effective May 21, 2018, hence **the members therein in respect of 1 constituency are set for retirement /renewal on May 20, 2020.**

The following exceptions were noted whereby replacements had taken place during the aforementioned terms of the Committees and hence the holders of office still have running terms:

- a) Embakasi South Constituency (Entire Committee)

- b) Embakasi Central Constituency (Male Adult Representative)
c) Jomvu Constituency (Female Adult Representative)
d) Mandera East Constituency (Male Adult Representative)
e) Ndhiwa Constituency (Male Adult Representative)
f) Nyando Constituency (Male Adult Representative)
g) Ugenya Constituency (Entire Committee Gazetted)

- h) Baringo South Constituency (Entire Committee Gazetted)
i) North Imenti Constituency (Female Youth Representative and Male Nominee of Constituency Office)

Accordingly, the National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) Board during its Board Meeting Number 128 held on October 28, 2019, passed a resolution to initiate the process of reconstitution of NGCDF Constituency Committees pursuant to authority given to it by Section 43(4) of the NGCDF Act 2015. This was in line with the term limits provided for NGCDF Constituency Committees, by Section 43(8) of the NGCDF Act 2015 which states, **“The term of office of the members of the Constituency Committee shall be two years and shall be renewable but shall expire upon the appointment of a new Constituency Committee in the manner provided for in the Act, or as maybe approved by the Board,”** and the need to commence the process of filling in the vacancies created in the membership of the said committees by re-convening Selection Panels in accordance with Regulation 5 of the Regulations to the NGCDF Act.

Pursuant to Sections 43(4) and 43(8) of the NG-CDF Act of 2015 & Regulation 5(10), which provide for National Assembly approval of the nominees for re-appointment or fresh appointment to the National Government Constituencies Development Fund Committees, prior to gazettelement by the National Government Constituencies Development Fund Board, as afore stated, we hereby forward the following names for approval by the National Assembly as appear hereunder:-


