POLICE BILL THIRD READING

The Crown Advocate moved the Third Reading of a Bill to amed the East African Police Ordinance 1906.

The Senior Commissioner seconded and this was agreed to without dissent.

MASTER AND SERVANT BILL- THIRD READING

The Grown Advocate moved the Third Reading of a Bill to amend the Master and Servant Ordinance 1906.

The Senior Commissioner seconded and this was agreed to without dissent.

VOLUTEER BILL - THIRD READING

The Crown Advocate moved the re-emmittal of a Bill to amend the East Africa Volunteer Reserve Bill for the consideration of Section 2(1).

Lord Delamere seconded and this was agreed to without dissent.

The Crown Advocate moved the adjournment of the consideration till Wednesday the 11th of September 1907.

The Land Commissioner seconded and this was agreed to without dissent.

ABOLITION OF SLAVERY -- BILL

The Crown Advocate moved that the Council go into

Committee to consider the Bill for the Abolition of Slavery
in the East Africa Protectorate.

The Senior Commissioner seconded and this was agreed to without dissent.

Section 15

The Crown Advocate moved the insertion at the end

of Section 15 of the words:

"for the purposes of this section the word
concubine! shall mean a female mem#ber
of the household who is an inmate of the
harem".

The Land Commissioner seconded and this was agreed to without dissent.

Section 6

Croww

The Grwn Advocate moved the insertion at the end of Section 6 of the following words:

" Provided however that the Court shall in no case award more than Rs 100 as compensation for the loss of Services of a slave."

The Land Commissioner seconded and this was agreed to without dissent.

After debate the Bill was reported to the Council.

The Crown Advocate gave notice that he would move
the Third Reading of the Bill on Thursday 12th September.

MUNICIPAL BILL -- SECOND READING

The Grown Advocate gave notice that he would move
the Second Reading of a Bill to provide for establisment
of Minicipal Councils in certain townships in this Protectorate.

The Land Commissioner seconded and this was agreed to without dissent.

SPECIAL COMMITTEE

The Land Commissioner moved that a Special Committee to consist of all the members of the Council except the Governor should be constituted to consider this Bill.

The Senior Commissioner seconded and this was agreed — to without dissent.

HIGH COURT BILL -- SECOND READING

The Crown Advocate moved the Second Reading of a
Bill to define the powers of the High Court and to constitute
and define the powers of the Courts subordinate thereto.

The Land Commissioner seconded and this was agreed to without dissent.

SPECIAL COMMITTEE

The Crown Advocate moved the formation od of a Speical Committee to consist of the Treasurer, the Crown Advocate and Mr Wilson to consider this bill.

The Senior Commissioner seconded and this was agreed to without dissent.

ADJOURNMENT
