REGARDING COMPLETION OF MZEE WANYAMA WATER DAM PROJECT IN NAKURU TOWN EAST CONSTITUENCY

I, the **UNDERSIGNED**, on behalf of the residents of Nakuru Town East Constituency,

DRAW the attention of the House to the following:

- 1) THAT, Article 43(1)(d) of the Constitution provides right to clean and safe water in adequate quantities for every Kenyan and that Article 21(2) places an obligation on the State to take measures to realize this right among others;
- **2) THAT,** in 2016, the Ministry of Water and Irrigation initiated construction of a water pan at Mzee Wanyama estate in Nakuru East Ward with hopes of mitigating the perennial water shortage experienced in the area;
- **3) THAT,** following commencement of the project, the contractor left the site before completion of the dam as stipulated on the plan;
- **4) THAT,** the dam in its current state is not functional and is instead a hazard as no barrier exists to prevent contamination of water and to ensure the safety of the locals;
- **5) THAT,** while the residents of Nakuru do appreciate the original intent of the project, they are dismayed by the fact that it was used in what they believe to be a means of embezzling public funds;

- **6) THAT,** the continuous shortage of water is detrimental to their health, animals and plants as the area is prime for agricultural practice;
- **7) THAT,** efforts to have the matter resolved by the relevant state agencies have been futile;
- **8) THAT,** the matter raised in this petition are not pending in any court of law, constitutional or statutory body;

THEREFORE, your humble petitioners pray that the National Assembly, through the Departmental Committee on Environment & Natural Resources investigates into the stalling of the project and appropriately resolves the matters herein to ensure provision of clean and adequate water to the affected residents of Nakuru Town East Constituency;

REGARDING MZEE WANYAMA WATER PAN/DAM IN NAKURU TOWN EAST CONSTITUENCY

TO THE SPEAKER OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY,

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I, the UNDERSCO ED, on behalf of the residents of Nakuru Town East Constituency;

DRAW attention of the House to the following:-

- THAT, Article 43(d) of the constitution safeguards the provision of water as a constitutional right for every Kenyan by establishing the right to clean and safe water in adequate quantities;
- 2. **THAT**, Article 21(2) places an obligation on the state and state organs to take legislative and other measures to realize this right.
- 3. **THAT** the ministry of water somewhere in 2016 embarked on constructing a water pan at Mzee Wanyama estate in Nakuru east ward with a view of mitigating the perennial water shortage in this area.
- 4. **THAT** sometime after the commencement of the project, the contractor left the site without completing the dam as originally stipulated on the plan despite having not redesigned the dam.
- 5. **THAT** upto date the dam is not functional as it cannot hold water, there exists no barrier to prevent contamination of water and to ensure safety of locals operating within the area and the area was never cleared to provide a clean environment for the dam.



- 6. **THAT** whereas the residents of Nakuru appreciate the original intent of the water pan, they harbour bitterness because what initially promised to be a solution to their problem ended up being a way of embezzling public funds.
- 7. **THAT** continued shortage of water is detrimental to their health, animals and plants as the area is prime for agricultural practice.
- 8. **THAT** efforts have been made to have the matters raised in this Petition addressed by the relevant ministry officers but there has been no response to this effect.
- 9. **THAT** the matters raised in this Petition are not also pending in any court of law in Kenya.
- 10. THAT the Petitioner therefore prays for-
 - (a) pursuant to Standing Order 216(5)(a, the relevant Committee of the House does investigate and inquire into all the matters raised in this Petition in particular on why the contractor was paid in full despite abandoning the dam incomplete and for legal action to be taken on the officers who were responsible for the dam
 - (b) Pursuant to Standing Order 216(5)(a), the relevant Committee of the House does make recommendations.
