### Introduction:

#### Grounds for Petition:

### False and Misleading Statements:

This statement is categorically false and baseless. Clinical officers are present in over 50 countries globally, with training programs extending up to the PhD level. Such misinformation undermines the credibility of the health sector and disrespects the clinical officer profession.

## Lack of Apology or Correction:

Despite the gravity of his erroneous statement, Dr. Amoth has neither issued a public correction nor an apology. This demonstrates a lack of accountability and disregard for the impact of his words on the clinical officer community and the broader healthcare NATIONAL ASSEMBLY
