

An Act of Parliament to amend the National Flag, Emblems and Names Act and for connected purposes

THE NATIONAL FLAG, EMBLEMS AND NAMES (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2014

AN ACT of Parliament to amend the National Flag, Emblems and Names Act and for connected purposes

ENACTED by the Parliament of Kenya, as follows—

1. This Act may be cited as the National Flag, Emblems and Names (Amendment) Act, 2014.

Short title.

2. The National Flag, Emblems and Names Act (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act") is amended in section 2 by inserting the following new definition in its proper alphabetical sequence—

Amendment of section 2 of Cap.

"motor vehicle" has the meaning assigned to it in the Traffic Act.

Cap. 403.

3. The principal Act is amended by inserting the following new section immediately after section 4—

Insertion of new section 4A in Cap. 99.

Flying of national flag on a motor vehicle.

- **4A.** (1) A person shall not fly the national flag on any motor vehicle.
 - (2) Notwithstanding subsection (1), the President, the Deputy-President, the Chief Justice, Cabinet Secretaries, the Speaker of the National Assembly, the Speaker of the Senate and Diplomats, while in foreign missions may fly the national flag on a motor vehicle.
 - (3) A person who contravenes subsection (1) commits an offence and shall be liable, on conviction, to a fine not exceeding one million shillings or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding five years, or both.
