

REPORT OF THE ESTIMATES COMMITTEE ON THE DRAFT ESTIMATES OF REVENUE AND EXPENDITURE OF THE NON-SELF-CONTAINED SERVICES OF THE EAST AFRICA HIGH COMMISSION FOR THE YEAR 1957/8

The Draft Estimates of Revenue and Expenditure of the Non-self-contained Services of the East Africa High Commission for the year 1957/8 were referred to the Committee by motion of the Central Legislative Assembly on 3rd April, 1957.

- 2. The Committee met on 3rd and 4th April, 1957, and examined the Draft Estimates in detail, together with recommendations made by the Research Councils.
- 3. The Committee recommended that proposals should be formulated to provide for a central organization to deal with all building and housing matters, and to make a report to the Standing Committee on Finance.
- 4. The Committee recommended that consideration should be given to changing the title of these Services to General Services, or some other suitable title.
- 5. The Committee agreed that it was essential that the research programmes of the organizations under the ægis of the Research Councils are printed in the Draft Estimates in future.
- 6. The Committee recommended that the East African Trypanosomiasis Research Organization should come under the ægis of the East African Agricultural and Fisheries Research Council and single line votes should be provided for the Organization as is the case with other Services under the Council.
- 7. The Committee recommended the appointment of a select committee of the Assembly to review Standing Rules and Orders and to make recommendations to the Central Legislative Assembly in December, 1957. The Committee should consist of the following Members:

The Financial Secretary.

The Hon. E. W. Mathu.

- 8. The Committee recommended that the Financial Secretary be authorized to make any necessary typographical amendments in the Estimates which involve no change in principle or the approved provision of funds.
- The Committee recommended the approval of the Draft Estimates subject to the amendments, modifications and observations set out below under the various heads of the Estimates.

EXPENDITURE

HEAD 1: OFFICE OF THE ADMINISTRATOR

(1) Administrator

The Committee recommended the inclusion of a post of Defence Secretary, one post of Assistant Secretary and one post of Personal Secretary Grade II, together with provision of £6,230.

The Committee recommended the deletion of one post of Establishment Officer, one post of Secretary Stenographer and two clerical posts, together with provision of £3,248.

In the interests of continuity and for the retention of a competent officer familiar with the work of the High Commission, the post of Assistant Secretary should be transferred from Head 1(4) Financial Secretary.
