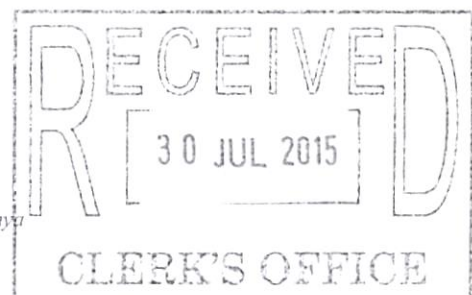

The Commission pursuant to its Constitutional and Statutory mandate undertakes investigations on its own initiative and or on receipt of reports. Our investigations are undertaken in a professional manner and in total observance of the law which is one of our core values.

The above notwithstanding, we hereby inform you that we have not commenced any investigations against Hon. Chris Wamalwa or in his Constituency Development Fund (CDF) and the allegations made on the floor of the house were false, malicious and with ulterior motive best known only to the Member of Parliament.




We however, are undertaking a study/research on evaluation of corruption in devolved funds in Kenya. The study/research is not restricted to a single constituency, county or even a region but on a selected sample size cutting across the County. This is a research exercise and not investigations. We will include a list of constituencies and counties where the survey on devolved funds is taking place in two phases. Currently, the exercise is on the second and final phase.

Whereas nothing stops the Commission from undertaking such investigations, we reiterate that the Hon. Member of Parliament has not been subjected to any interview or been visited by any of our officers and he is by a copy of this letter advised to report to the Commission or Police persons allegedly investigating him for their arrest.

We interpret this to be intimidation of the Commission and its staff with the intention of impeding our performance pursuant to our mandate and we take this opportunity to strongly protest this action and seek your protection from such unwanted harassment.

We assure you that the Commission shall continue to discharge its mandate without fear or favour and in accordance with the law. No amount of intimidation or harassment will dissuade us from discharging our mandate.

STATUS OF AN EVALUATION OF CORRUPTION IN THE DEVOLVED FUNDS

The Ethics and Anti-Corruption Commission is currently carrying out a study to Evaluate Corruption in the Devolved Funds. The Study is being carried out in 15 Counties and 30 Constituencies across the country. The first phase started on 17th May 2015 in the following nine counties and 21 constituencies until 11th June 2015.

In this phase, the research team was denied permission to conduct interviews in Murang'a and Nairobi County Offices and Kitui Central and Rural Constituencies.

SECOND PHASE OF THE EVALUATION

The second phase which is currently on going commenced on 27th July 2015 and is projected to end by 7th August 2015. The Evaluation is covering six counties and nine constituencies as follows.

METHODOLOGY

The study takes a random sample of 15 counties that represent 32 percent of the 47 counties. The geographical location, population and regional development were key characteristics considered in selecting 15 counties and constituencies for the study.

The target respondents are interviews with members of the public, Staff of sampled counties and constituencies including Members of Parliament and county officers and suppliers/contractors of Fund projects.

SITE VISITS

The Research team further peruses through procurement files to collect information on tenders and suppliers. The information is then used to make site visits of ongoing and completed development projects in the sampled counties and constituencies.

FINDINGS OF THE EVALUATION

The findings of this evaluation will assist the Commission to make recommendations to seal any corruption loopholes identified in the implementation of other similar projects in future.

We are in receipt of your letter **Ref. No. COG/6/12 Vol. 3** dated **2nd June 2015** on the above subject matter, the contents whereof were noted with surprise and disappointment.

At the outset, please be informed that the Ethics and Anti-Corruption Commission (EACC) is established under Section 3 of the Ethics and Anti-Corruption Commission Act No. 22 of 2011 (EACC Act) pursuant to Article 79 of the Constitution with the mandate to combat and prevent corruption and unethical conduct in Kenya through law enforcement, public education, review of systems of public entities and promotion of best practices and standards in ethics and integrity.


Section 11 (i) of the EACC Act mandates the Commission to monitor the practices and procedures of public bodies to detect corrupt practices and to secure the revision of the methods of work or procedures that may be conducive to corrupt practices. The Commission undertakes this function through various mechanisms which include but not limited to research and evaluation such as the one currently taking place.

It is in light of the foregoing that the Commission as herein stated is conducting the ongoing Study on Evaluation of Corruption in Devolved Funds in Kenya. The study is aimed at identifying loopholes in procedures prone to corruption with a view to sealing them. It is envisaged that the findings will help in the development and implementation of appropriate anti-corruption initiatives to enhance transparency and accountability in the management of public funds in the county governments.

We must also draw your attention to Section 11(2) of the EACC Act that criminalizes actions that contravene the above legal provisions. Further, Section 28 of the Act provides that the Commission shall in the performance of its functions not be subject to the direction or control of any person or authority. These includes inter alia county governments. In the discharge of its mandate, the Commission cannot be restricted or curtailed as you erroneously purport to do.

To this end, the Commission will continue to proclaim its constitutional independence and full execution of its mandate including conducting the current study. County Governments are therefore advised to support and cooperate with the Commission in this important exercise.

We refer to the above matter and further to your letter to the Governor of Murang'a County, dated 6th May, 2015. The Council Secretariat has been instructed by its legal Counsel to write to you with regard to the issues raised in the letter as follows:

1. Research into the management of the County Revenue Fund

The Constitution at Article 207 establishes a Revenue Fund for each County Government, into which shall be paid all money raised or received by or on behalf of the County Government. The Public Finance Management Act (PFMA) at Section 109 establishes for each County a County Revenue Fund.

Article 226 of the Constitution states as follows:

(2) *The accounting officer of a national public entity is accountable to the National Assembly for its financial management, and the accounting officer of a county public entity is accountable to the county assembly for its financial management.*

(3) *Subject to clause (4), the accounts of all governments and State organs shall be audited by the Auditor-General.*

assembly shall debate and consider the report and take appropriate action.

From the above, it is clear that there are appropriate oversight mechanisms over the management of the County Revenue Fund vested in the respective County Assemblies of the Counties and the Auditor-General. Further, the Controller of Budget under Article 228 and in Section 109 of the PFMA is also mandated to oversee implementation of budgets of the National and County Governments and in this regard is tasked with generation and submission of a report to each House of Parliament.

On the above premise, the EACC would be undertaking a task already being undertaken by the Auditor-General and the respective County Assemblies by 'interviewing members of the public and public officers involved in the management of the County Revenue Fund'.

2. Perusal of procurement files and project visits

As stated earlier, oversight mechanisms on procurement are canvassed, in among others, Article 226 which illuminates that the accounting officer of a county public entity is accountable to the County Assembly for its financial management. The Office of the Auditor-General is also the appropriate office to inquire into the procurement processes to ascertain the proper use of funds according to the laid down procurement rules.

3. Taskforce on the Review of the legal, policy and institutional framework for fighting corruption in Kenya

In your letter, you intimate that the proposed 'study seeks to identify the existing loopholes and procedures prone to corruption in the devolved funds and propose measures to seal those loopholes'. The Council notes that through Gazette Notice No. 2118 of 31st March, 2015, the Office of the Attorney-General appointed a taskforce to review the legal, policy and institutional framework for fighting corruption in Kenya.

mandate since the Constitution is unequivocal on who undertakes oversight over the Counties.


Further, as this is a study, the Council is not in receipt of the Terms of Reference for sharing with the County Governments. We are not aware of the expected outputs or the parameters of the proposed study. Though EACC can choose to undertake research, you must consult the Counties in order to agree on the terms of reference and time frames. This would be done so as to allow County teams be available to meet your officials.

5. Devolved Funds

The Constitution and the Public Finance Management Act do not recognize the terms 'devolved funds'. Funds can only follow functions, they are not devolved.

The Council would like to mention that it welcomes the initiative and would encourage collaboration and dialogue to enable achievement of each of our mandates. However, in light of the above enumerated issues, the Council hereby calls for the immediate withdrawal of your Research Teams and requests that the Commission respects the distinctness and autonomy of Counties. Additionally, EACC must respect the Constitution by allowing the set oversight institutions to play their roles.

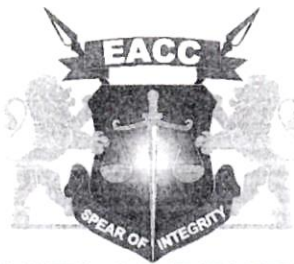

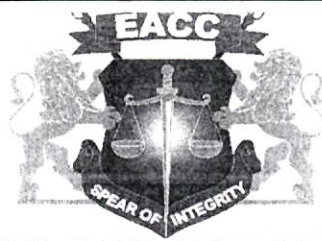

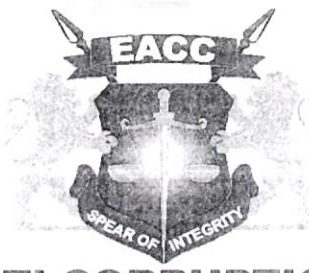
