Termination of Conscription

The following arrangements have been made for the termination of conscription :-

- 1) No further compulsory labour will be recruited after December 31st 1945.
- 2) Labour on contract at that date will complete its period of service, subject to the limitation that this service will not extend beyond the following dates :-
 - a) in the case of sisal and essential foodstuffs for local consumption (including sugar) September 30th 1946.
 - b) In the case of other essential undertakings (including flax, rubber, etc.) March 31st, 1946.
