REPORT OF THE CONTROLLER AND AUDITOR GENERAL ON THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS OF THE PYRETHRUM BOARD OF KENYA FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30 JUNE 2003

I have examined the financial statements of Pyrethrum Board of Kenya for the year ended 30 June 2003 in accordance with the provisions of Section 29 of the Exchequer and Audit Act, (Cap 412). I have obtained all the information and explanations considered necessary for the purpose of the audit. Proper books of account have been kept and the financial statements which have been prepared under the historical cost convention are in agreement therewith and comply with the Pyrethrum Act (Cap 340).

1. FIXED ASSETS

The fixed assets balance of Kshs. 170,062,515 as at 30 June 2003 excludes undetermined value of 12 plots whose title deeds the Board has not acquired. Apart from the fact that the plots have not been valued for inclusion in the financial statements it has not been possible to confirm their ownership by the Board in the absence of title deeds.

2. DEBTORS AND PREPAYMENTS

The debtors balance of Kshs. 315,191,098 as at 30 June 2003 includes an amount of Kshs. 26,058,505 owed by staff, ex-staff and former Board Members. The amount further includes Kshs. 6,905,568 which was not analyzed and could not therefore, be verified. The recoverability of debts owed by ex-staff totalling Kshs. 17,449,704 and former Board members of Kshs. 1,703,233 is doubtful since most of these have been outstanding for over (8) eight years. No provision has been made in these financial statements for non recovery of these debts.

Except for the foregoing reservations, in my opinion, the financial statements when read together with the notes thereon present fairly the financial state of affairs of the Pyrethrum Board of Kenya as at 30 June 2003 and of its loss and cash flows for the year then ended.

PYRETHRUM BOARD OF KENYA NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30 JUNE 2003

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

(a) Accounting convention

The accounts are prepared under the historical cost convention

(b) **Depreciation**

Depreciation has been charged on the cost of the fixed assets at the following rates:-

Buildings 2% p a

Plant, machinery, equipment & furniture 12.5% p.a.

Motor vehicles 25% p.a.

The rates are designed to write off such cost over the estimated useful life of the assets concerned

(c) Stock

Stock has been valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value. Stocks of powder and extract have been valued on the basis of prime cost based on the interim price paid for pyrethrins. Stores have been valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value, and work-in-progress at the cost of raw materials plus labour and overheads directly attributable to their manufacture.

(d) Turnover

Turnover is the amount derived from the sale of pyrethrum products after deduction of trade discounts and commissions payable to overseas agents, and after adjustments for profits or losses on translation of foreign currencies

(e) Foreign currency translation

Assets and liabilities denominated in foreign currencies are translated into Kenya Shillings at the mid-rate of exchange ruling on the balance sheet date. Exchange differences derived from the fluctuation of foreign currency denominated sales debtors or commissions creditors between the rate applied at the invoice date and the rate ruling at the date of settlement or year-end, as applicable, are included as part of the turnover of the Board.
