- 1. The residents of Ganjoni have occupied this area for more than 50 years
- 2. Africa Ports Terminal Limited is the owner of Iron ore which is stored in an open field at COMACO.
- 3. Loading and off loading during the day and night making noise and inconveniencing the residents.
- 4. The dust particles from the iron ore during the loading and off loading is affecting the residents which is health hazard
 - The residents petitioned NEMA where a meeting was held between the residents and the company which resolution were made:-
- a) THAT COMARCO should strictly adhere to the conditions of the licence operation timelines between 8.00 am to 5.00 pm.
- b) THAT COMACO to continue sprinkling water on the yard and loaded trucks for every 30min so as to prevent dust from billowing into the residential.
- c) THAT operations of loading and offloading of iron ore at the yard to stop by the end of September 20919 to allow for construction of a proper shade before next consignment.
- d) THAT the owner of the company to take samples of iron ore to the Government Chemist for testing to ascertain any residual health effects to the residents.

All the above conditions were ignored or disobeyed by COMACO.
